Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of recruitment letters pertaining to Central Government handed over during Rozgar Mela since 1st December, 2023 to 30th November, 2024, Ministry/Department/PSU-wise;
- (b) the number of recruitment letters handed over to General, SC, ST and OBC candidates out of the above, Ministry/Department/PSU-wise; and
- (c) the number of vacancies Government has targeted to fill up by 31st December, 2024, Ministry/Department/PSU-wise?

(a) to (c) : The Hon'ble Prime Minister had launched the Rozgar Mela on 22nd October 2022. A total of 13 Rozgar Melas have so far been held at central level in 45-50 cities across various States/Union Territories. As part of Rozgar Mela, the vacant posts in Central Government Ministries and various Organizations of Central Government are being filled up in a Mission Mode. Several lakhs of appointment letters have been issued during the Rozgar Melas.

Details of various recruitments and vacancies, including category wise breakup are maintained by respective Ministries /Departments/ Central Public Sector Undertakings (CPSUs) and the concerned recruitment agencies such as Union Public Service Commission (UPSC), Staff Selection Commission (SSC), Railway Recruitment Board (RRB), Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS) etc.
