AREA UNDER PADDY CULTIVATION IN CHHATTISGARH

1282. SMT. PHULO DEVI NETAM:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the area of land on which paddy is being sown in Chhattisgarh during the last five years, district-wise;
- (b) the details of incentives being provided to farmers for sowing paddy in Chhattisgarh; and
- (c) whether it is a fact that farmers of many districts of Chhattisgarh have been prohibited by Government to sow paddy, if so, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a): The district-wise details of area under paddy cultivation in Chhattisgarh over the last five years are at Annexure.
- (b): Government of India supplements the efforts of States through appropriate policy measures and budgetary support through various schemes/ programmes for benefit of farmers such as Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN), Pradhan Mantri Kisan Maan Dhan Yojana (PM-KMY), Minimum Support Price (MSP), Kisan Credit Card (KCC), Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY)-Per Drop More Crop, Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY), Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY), Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), Sub-Mission on Agricultural Mechanization(SMAM), Central Sector Scheme on Crop Residue Management etc.
- (c): As per the information received from the Government of Chhattisgarh, no farmers have been prohibited from sowing paddy.
