INITIATIVES TO INCREASE PRODUCTION OF KASTURI COTTON

1293. DR. MEDHA VISHRAM KULKARNI:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any special initiatives have been taken to increase the production of Kasturi Cotton India in Maharashtra and Gujarat;
- (b) if so, the details of the measures implemented to support local farmers in these States;
- (c) whether any achievements have been recorded since the launch of Kasturi Cotton India in November 2023; and
- (d) if so, whether these achievements include increase in the income of farmers in Maharashtra and Gujarat; the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR TEXTILES (SHRI PABITRA MARGHERITA)

- (a) & (b): The Kasturi Cotton Bharat is a traceability, certification and branding initiative for lint cotton bales, focusing on post-harvest processes. To raise awareness about the premium potential for cotton meeting Kasturi standards, multiple seminars and workshops were organized across various States. As of 3rd December, 2024, 464 units have been on-boarded, including 374 ginners and 90 supply chain members, with Maharashtra and Gujarat contributing 149 and 87 units, respectively.
- (c) & (d): A website has been launched for providing information and timely updates on this initiative. Further, a certification protocol has been finalized for standardizing 29 mm and 30 mm long-staple cotton. As of 3rd December, 2024, a total of 47,600 bales have been certified as 'Kasturi' Cotton including 3,200 bales and 800 bales of Maharashtra and Gujarat, respectively.
