MODERNISATION PLAN OF SCL, MOHALI

1353. SHRI VIKRAMJIT SINGH SAHNEY:

Will the Minister of ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government had announced in February 2024 that a modernisation plan of ₹10,000 crore for Semi Conductor Lab (SCL), Mohali was ready and Government will be selecting a partner for that and that the proposal was to be sent to Cabinet by June 2024;
- (b) if so, the details of the complete plan;
- (c) whether the plan has been sent to the Cabinet for approval; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): Government has approved Semicon India programme with a total outlay of INR 76,000 crore for the development of semiconductor and display manufacturing ecosystem in the country. Under this programme, Government has also approved modernisation of Semi-Conductor Laboratory (SCL), Mohali.

The Government is in the process of taking inputs from the concerned stakeholders for modernization of SCL Mohali.
