STEPS TO REKINDLE THE TEXTILE SECTOR

(a) to (d): Government is implementing various schemes/ programmes in the textile sector for (i) augmenting growth and investment (ii) generating employment and (iii) promoting entrepreneurship in the sector. Some of the programmes include Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for Textiles, Pradhan Mantri Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel Parks (PM-MITRA), National Technical Textile Mission (NTTM), Silk Samagra, SAMARTH—Scheme for Capacity Building in Textiles Sector, National Handloom Development Programme (NHDP), National Handicraft Development Programme (NHDP), National Jute Development Programme (NJDP), Integrated Wool Development Programme (IWDP), Textile Cluster Development Scheme (TCDS) and others.
