RATIO OF MALE TO FEMALE SECURITY PERSONNEL

- a) the ratio of male to female travelers at airports;
- b) the ratio of male to female security personnel at security check booths at airports; and
- c) the reason for having fewer lines for females than males at security checks at airports?

(a) to (c): The ratio of male to female travelers varies at different airports from time to time. The ratio of male to female security personnel at security check booths also varies from airport to airport depending upon the operational requirements and passenger traffic. However, on an average the ratio of male to female security personnel at security check booths at airports is 3:1. The number of male and female security check booths are defined considering the passenger load at the respective airport.
