(a) & (b): Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS), the aviation security regulator of India envisages for installation of CTX at new and major airports so as not to divest electronic items from hand baggage during security check. The rollout of CTX is pending for evolving technical specifications and Standard Operating Procedure by BCAS.
