**ACHIEVEMENTS OF PRIME MINISTER'S EMPLOYMENT GENERATION SCHEME**

- (a) the State-wise achievements of the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Scheme during the last three years; and  
(b) whether government would like to submit a concrete action plan to ensure 100 per cent success of the scheme?

(a): State wise performance of the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Scheme during the last three financial years is given at **Annexure I**.

(b): Government has taken the following measures to ensure success of the scheme:

- Enhancement of maximum project cost from Rs. 25 lakh to Rs. 50 lakh for manufacturing sector and from Rs. 10 lakh to Rs. 20 lakh for service sector.
- Inclusion of applicants from Aspirational districts and transenders under Special Category eligible for higher subsidy.
- Awareness programmes in all the States/UTs including backward and under-performing areas, Aspirational districts, North Eastern Region, etc.
- Exclusion of COVID years i.e., FY2020-21 and FY2021-22 while considering profitability of existing PMEGP/ MUDRA units applying for 2nd loan tranche.
- Conduct of two-days free online Entrepreneurship Development Programme (EDP) for prospective entrepreneurs.
- Acceptance of PMEGP applications from prospective beneficiaries in 11 regional languages since January 2024.
