- (a) whether it is a fact that as per NITI Aayog's Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) India Index 2023-24, which evaluates progress of States on social and economic parameters, Bihar is the worst performing State in overall SDG score;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that Bihar's performance in SDG 2, (including indicators such as stunted and underweight children and anaemic pregnant women) is extremely poor in comparison to other States and UT's; and
- (c) if so, the steps taken by Government to improve the aforesaid situation and the details thereof?

The score has steadily improved from 48 in 2018 to 50 in 2019-20, 52 in 2020-21, and 57 in 2023-24.
