STATUS OF TRAUMA CENTRES IN THE COUNTRY

1705: SHRI SANJAY SINGH:

Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Government trauma centres available in the country, the details thereof, State -wise;
- (b) the number of trauma centres fully functional/partially functional/non-functional out of all Government trauma centres available in the country, the details thereof, State-wise and category-wise;
- (c) the number of trauma centres facing shortage of doctors/surgeons/specialists and other staff; and
- (d) the detail of sanctioned/vacant/filled posts of doctors/surgeons/specialists and other staff in trauma centres during the last five years?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

- (a): During 11th Five Year Plan (2007-2012) and 12th Five Year Plan (2012-2017) under the "National Programme for Prevention & Management of Trauma and Burn Injuries" (NPPMT&BI), total 196 Trauma Care Facilities (TCFs) were sanctioned in Government Hospitals/ Medical Colleges across the country. NPPMT&BI is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme. The overall objective of the scheme is to bring down preventable deaths due to road accidents by developing a Pan-India trauma care network. Details of sanctioned TCFs are at Annexure –I.
- (b): As informed by States, total 163 Trauma Care Centres are functional out of 196 centres. Remaining Trauma Centres are at various stages to become functional.
- (c) & (d): As per guidelines of NPPMT&BI, doctors/ surgeons/ specialists and other staff are posted in Trauma Care Centres by concerned State Government from their available resources. Details about the shortage of doctors/surgeons/specialists and other staff in trauma centres are not maintained at central level.
