STUDENTS ADMITTED IN MBBS COURSES THROUGH NEET

1709. Dr. ANBUMANI RAMADOSS:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of students admitted in MBBS courses for the academic year 2024-2025 based on NEET exams;
- (b) the details thereof, State-wise, attempt-wise, category-wise and college (Government/private)-wise; and
- (c) the cut off details of the NEET exams for the year 2024, category(GC, EWS, OBC, SC & ST)-wise and State-wise?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a) to (c): As informed by the National Medical Commission (NMC), there are total number of 1,18,137 undergraduate medical seats, which include 60,422 seats in government medical colleges and 57,715 seats in private medical colleges.

The National Testing Agency (NTA), under the Ministry of Education, conducts the NEET-UG. The candidates who qualify the examination are eligible for counseling in medical colleges. The Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) of Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) conducts the counselling for seats of undergraduate (UG/MBBS) medical courses as per the scheme devised by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Counselling for UG covers 15% all India quota seats; 100% seats of Central Institutes/Universities, Deemed Universities; 100% seats in all the Institutes of National Importance (INI). The details of allocation of seats in various stages of counselling are available in public domain at https://mcc.nic.in.

Counselling for the State quota seats in UG and PG medical courses is conducted by the respective State Governments.
