(a) & (b): The National Council for Teacher Education in its 55th meeting held on 14th July, 2022 decided that the online portal for inviting fresh/revised applications should not be opened till the formulation of norms and curriculum aligned with the National Education Policy, 2020.

As and when NCTE opens its online portal for inviting applications from Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) across the country, institutions of Kerala may also apply for recognition of their courses.

(c) & (d): As conveyed by NCTE, no proposal for recognition of B.Ed programme has been received from the Government of Kerala since 2019.
