- (a) the number of new Universities that have been established in the country during the last five years;
- (b) the number of Government and private Universities established among those universities that have been established:
- (c) whether it is a fact that the maximum number of private Universities have been established in the State of Gujarat, and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the States where the highest number of Government Universities have been established and the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) & (b) As per All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE), 220 Universities have been registered in AISHE during 2018-19 to 2022-23 (Provisional). Among those, 107 are Government Universities and 113 are Private Universities.
- (c) Yes, the State of Gujarat has maximum number of Private Universities. As per AISHE 2022-23 (Provisional), there are 62 Private Universities registered in AISHE.
- (d) As per AISHE 2022-23 (Provisional), the top 3 States where maximum number of Government Universities are registered in AISHE are Uttar Pradesh (56), West Bengal (47) and Karnataka (44).
