(a) to (b): Details of funds allocated to schools under the Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan in each district of the Konkan region may be seen at Annexure-I. District wise the number of schools that have received financial assistance may be seen in the below table:

(c): Under Samagra Shiksha, the annual plans are prepared by the States and UTs based on their requirements and priorities as per the components mentioned in the Samagra Shiksha framework and this is reflected in their respective Annual Work Plan and Budget (AWP&B) Proposals. These plans are then appraised and approved/estimated by the Project Approval Board (PAB) in the Department of School Education & Literacy in consultation with the States and UTs as per the programmatic and financial norms of the scheme, and physical and financial progress of the State for the interventions approved earlier. Based on the approved AWP&B, the Central Share under Samagra Shiksha is released to the respective State Government in four

installments as per financial norms and not district-wise or component-wise. Furthermore, it is upon the State to use the fund as per its priority and needs.

(d): Education reform in this region is a continuous process, with Samagra Shiksha dedicated to enhancing educational outcomes by prioritizing quality training and continuous professional development for teachers. The scheme focuses on reducing dropout rates, improving attendance, ensuring timely infrastructure upgrades and facilitating smoother implementation of educational initiatives.
