**KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS IN CHHATTISGARH**

**179 SHRI RAJEEV SHUKLA:**

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) present in Chhattisgarh as of date, district-wise;
- (b) the total strength of students as well as teachers presently enrolled in KVs in Chhattisgarh;
- (c) whether the State Government of Chhattisgarh has submitted any proposal for the opening of new KVs across the State; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

- (a) At present, 1253 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) including 36 KVs in the State of Chhattisgarh are functioning across the country. District-wise details of 36 KVs in the State of Chhattisgarh are annexed.
- (b) As per the information received from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), the total strength of students enrolled in the KVs in Chhattisgarh is 36,689 as on 30.09.2024 and total 1100 regular teaching staff is in position as on 01.11.2024 in these KVs.
- (c) & (d) Opening of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) is a continuous process. KVs are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence & Para-military personnel, Central Autonomous Bodies, Central Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Central Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) by providing a common programme of education throughout the country. Proposals for opening of new KVs may be sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) Administrations, with commitment to provide requisite resources including land and temporary accommodation for setting up a new KV as per norms.

The Ministry / Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) continuously receives proposals/requests from the various Sponsoring Authorities/public representatives for opening of new KVs. Such proposals/ requests received from the Sponsoring Authorities/public representatives for opening of new KVs are examined/processed at various levels before approval of the competent authority is sought as per the extant procedures.

As per information received from KVS, 04 proposals for opening of new KVs in the State of Chhattisgarh i.e.(i) Mungeli, District Mungeli (ii) Surajpur, District Surajpur (iii) Bemetara, District Bemetara and (iv) Hasoud, District Janjgir Champa, Chhattisgarh have been received.
