**HEMS IN HIMACHAL PRADESH**

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether Government proposes to develop Helicopter Emergency Medical Service(HEMS) units alongwith National Highways (NHs) and Expressways (EXPYs);
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether Government plans to adopt a bottom-up approach where every hilly area of the State will get at least one HEMS in Himachal Pradesh?

(a) to (c): Ministry of Civil Aviation in collaboration with Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) and the Government of Uttarakhand, has launched Helicopter Emergency Medical Service (HEMS) under the pilot project 'Sanjeevani' on 29th October, 2024 at All India Institute Of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) , Rishikesh covering a 150 km radius to deliver speedy medical care to needy citizens.

At present, the Government of India has no other proposal or plan and HEMS has so far been launched on a pilot basis only in the State of Uttarakhand.
