STATUS OF HANSPAL FLYOVER AT BHUBANESWAR

1821. SHRI NIRANJAN BISHI: DR. SASMIT PATRA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the construction of the six-lane flyover on NH-16 near Hanspal, connecting Bhubaneswar with Cuttack, which began in 2020, has faced delays despite an initial two-year completion timeline;
- (b) the specific reasons for these delays and the measures taken to address them;
- (c) the impact of these delays on daily commuters between Bhubaneswar and Cuttack, given the ongoing traffic issues caused by the construction of flyover; and
- (d) the expected date of completion of this flyover and whether any further steps are being taken to expedite the project?

- (a) to (b) Yes Sir, The construction of the said flyover got delayed due to Covid-19 pandemic, delay in removal/relocation of houses/structures and poor performance of the EPC contractor.
- (c) to (d) The EPC Contract has been terminated in June 2024 due to non performance of the EPC Contractor and balance work has been re-awarded. The work is expected to be completed by January, 2025.
