One Nation, One Location

1854. Dr. MEDHA VISHRAM KULKARNI: and

SHRI MADAN RATHORE:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the primary goals of the 'One Nation, One Location' initiative;
- (b) whether Government plans to achieve the integration of various transportation modes under the One Nation, One Location initiative; and
- (c) the benefits of integrating transportation systems for both urban and rural areas?

- (a) &(b) While the Government has no such initiative as 'One Nation, One Location', one major policy is, however, to seamlessly integrate various modes of transportation along with mechanized facilities of cargo handling and freight aggregation/ disaggregation by developing Multi-Modal Logistics Parks (MMLPs) at 35 strategic locations identified across the country.
- (c) Integrating transportation systems for both urban and rural areas will bring down logistics cost and lead to increase in logistics efficiency and economic productivity.
