(b)whether Government is working on any scheme to construct roads with width of more than 8 lanes, if so, the details thereof; and

(c)whether any work related to construction of 8-lane roads is proposed in Bihar, if so, the details thereof and, if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) The State-wise length of 2-lane, 4-lane, 6/8 lane National Highways (NH) projects of Ministry of Road Transport & Highways constructed during the current financial year, balance length under construction and length of projects awarded for construction are annexed.

(b) and (c) No, Sir. The construction of NHs is a continuous process and works for widening of NHs including 8-lane are taken up by the Government based on traffic density and inter-se priority of works. Presently, no NH project for 8-lane has been sanctioned/awarded for construction in the State of Bihar.
