SUCCESS OF PRADHAN MANTRI KAUSHAL VIKAS YOJANA (PMKVY)

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken under Skill India Mission for skill upgradation of youth and whether these skills are helping them to get jobs in the respective sectors; and
- (b) the number of candidates trained under PMKVY in Gujarat, especially in Mehsana?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(a): Under the Government of India's Skill India Mission (SIM), the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, re-skill and up-skill training through an extensive network of skill development centres / institutes etc. under various schemes, viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to all the sections of the society including youth across the country. The SIM aims at enabling youth of India to get future ready, equipped with industry relevant skills.

As per the third-party impact evaluation of PMKVY by the Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), 70.5% surveyed candidates received placement in their desired skill sector and the third-party evaluation report of JSS scheme has observed that 77.05% of the beneficiary trainees have undergone occupational shifts. The Tracer Study of ITI Graduates mentions that 63.5% of total ITI pass-outs got employed, out of which 6.7% were self-employed. Placements were tracked in the Short-Term Training (STT) component in the first three versions of the Scheme (PMKVY 1.0, PMKVY 2.0 and PMKVY 3.0) implemented from FY 2015-16 to FY 2021-22. Under PMKVY (1.0 to 3.0), 24.38 lakh candidates have been reported placed which includes both self-employed and wage employed. Under PMKVY4.0, the focus is on empowering our trained candidates to choose their varied career path and they are suitably oriented for the same. Further, various IT tools like skill India digital hub also gives this opportunity.

(b): Since 2015-16 up to 31st October 2024, the number of candidates trained under PMKVY in Gujrat and Mehsana District are 4,67,349 and 20,486 respectively.
