PRADHAN MANTRI ADARSH GRAM YOJANA

1892. SHRI NARAYANA KORAGAPPA

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:-

- (a) the steps taken under Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAGY) to develop villages with minimum needs of society;
- (b) the number of villages selected, work undertaken and the number of people getting benefits from the scheme in Karnataka taluk-wise, district-wise; and
- (c) specific monitorable indicators to evaluate any village as “Adarsh Gram”?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT

(SHRI RAMDAS ATHAWALE)

(a) In 2021-22 the erstwhile scheme of Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAGY) has been subsumed under the umbrella Scheme Pradhan Mantri Anusuchit Jaati Abhyuday Yojana (PM-AJAY). The villages having more than 40% SC population and a total population of 500 or more are eligible for selection under the Scheme. The selected villages are saturated with identified 50 Socio-Economic developmental indicators under 10 domains namely Drinking Water and Sanitation, Education, Health and Nutrition, Social Security, Rural Roads and Housing, Electricity and Clean Fuel, Agricultural Practices, Financial Inclusion, Digitization, Livelihood and Skill Development which are the minimum requirements for any person residing in a village.

(b) In Karnataka, under Adarsh Gram Component of PM-AJAY, a total of 1723 villages have been selected, 16,712 works have been undertaken and 14,93,685 beneficiaries have been covered. The details are at **Annexure-I**.

(c) The list of 50 socio-economic developmental Monitorable Indicators to evaluate villages as “Adarsh Gram” is at **Annexure-II**.
