Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether adequate funds have been allocated for welfare of Tribals under different heads in J&K during last five years, if so, the details thereof head/sector-wise; and

(b) the details of district-wise expenditure incurred under various heads during last five years?

(a) to (b): Government is implementing Development Action Plan for Scheduled Tribes (DAPST) as a strategy for the development of Scheduled Tribes and areas having tribal concentration in the country. Besides Ministry of Tribal Affairs, 41 Ministries/Departments are allocating certain percentage of their total scheme budget every year for tribal development under DAPST for various tribal development projects relating to education, health, agriculture, irrigation, roads, housing, electrification, employment generation, skill development, etc. The details of fund released under DAPST by Ministries/Departments to Jammu & Kashmir during last five years is as under:
