Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is aware of the current value of Telephone towers and Telephone exchanges installed by BSNL throughout the country, if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (b) whether Government has taken steps to monetize such large volumes of telephone towers and telephone exchanges by leasing out them to private telecom players like Jio, Airtel, TATA, Vodaphone India and others, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the income generated through this in the last five years, year-wise?

- (a) BSNL's asset of Towers, Apparatus and Plants has Gross block book value of Rs.68,256.21 Cr. as on 31.03.2024.
- **(b)& (c)** As on 31.03.2024, BSNL has leased out total 12,502 towers to various Telecom Operators. The details of Revenue on account of letting/leasing out of BSNL's Towers is as below:
