Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total sanctioned strength of IAS, IPS and IFS officers compared to the total in-person strength at present, cadre-wise and State-wise, including year-wise and category-wise details of appointments made to All India Services (IAS, IPS, and IFS) from General, Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs), and Other Backward Classes (OBCs) during the last five years; and
- (b) the total number of vacancies in direct recruitment and promotion posts, cadre-wise and State-wise and the reasons for the backlog in filling these promotion quota vacancies?

Backlog in filling promotion quota vacancies are due to non-submission of necessary proposals by the State Government resulting in non-holding of Selection Committee meetings by UPSC, or non-availability of eligible State Civil Services Officers.
