SPORTS INFRASTRUCTURE IN ASSAM

2066. MS. SUSHMITA DEV:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state :-

- (a) the number of new functional sports infrastructure projects in Assam in the last five years, district-wise, sport-wise;
- (b) the funds allocated and released to Assam under Khelo India Scheme since its inception; and
- (c) the number of projects sanctioned and completed under 'Utilisation and creation/upgradation of sports infrastructure' in Assam since its inception?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) 'Sports' being a State subject, the responsibility of development of sports, including development of sports infrastructure, rests primarily with the State/Union Territory Governments. The Union Government supplements their efforts by bridging critical gaps. The sports infrastructure present in various parts of the country are under the jurisdiction of the respective bodies/Department of State/UT Governments. The information about them is maintained by the respective State/UT. The details of the sports infrastructure projects sanctioned under "Creation and upgradation of sports infrastructure" component of the Khelo India Scheme, along with the status of funds released, project-wise, across the country, including in the State of Assam, are available in public domain on the dashboard at <https://mdsd.kheloindia.gov.in>. Further, funds are allocated and released scheme-wise, not state-wise in this Ministry. Details of funds allocated and released under the Khelo India Scheme, since its inception, across the country, including in the State of Assam, are as under:
