KHELO INDIA SCHEME IN CHHATTISGARH

2078. SMT. RANJEET RANJAN:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state :-

- (a) the number of existing playgrounds that have been upgraded or constructed in Chhattisgarh under the Khelo India Scheme along with the funds released in this regard;
- (b) the details of individuals who benefited from the said scheme in Chhattisgarh;
- (c) the number of athletes from Chhattisgarh who have participated in Khelo India national and State-level competitions, and the support they have received;
- (d) the number of women athletes who have received financial support from the said scheme; and
- (e) the measures taken to ensure their training, competition participation, and overall development?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS

(DR. MANSUKH MANDAVIYA)

(a) Under the “Creation and upgradation of sports infrastructure” component of the Khelo India Scheme, this Ministry renders financial support for creation of basic sports infrastructure such as sports complex, synthetic athletic tracks, synthetic hockey fields, synthetic turf football grounds, multipurpose halls, swimming pools, playgrounds, etc. and for sports equipments. The details of the sports infrastructure sanctioned along with their financial implications under Khelo India Scheme, across the country, including in the State of Chhattisgarh, are available in public domain on the dashboard of the Ministry at <https://mdsd.kheloindia.gov.in>.

(b) Khelo India Scheme aims at mass participation. The sports facilities developed under the Khelo India Scheme are open to all. The details of Khelo India Athletes identified under the Khelo India Scheme, across the country, including in the state of Chhattisgarh, are available in public domain on the dashboard of the Ministry at <https://dashboard.kheloindia.gov.in/state-wise-khelo-india-centers>.

(c) The details of participation of athletes from Chhattisgarh in Khelo India Games (National Level competition) are at Annexure – I.

(d) and (e) The details of female Khelo India Athletes across the country, who have received financial support under the Khelo India Scheme, are available in public domain on the dashboard of the Ministry at <https://dashboard.kheloindia.gov.in/state-wise-khelo-india-centers>. Under the component, “Sports Competition and Talent Development” of the Khelo India Scheme, talented

sportspersons nationwide are identified as a Khelo India Athlete (KIA). Selection of these athletes is based on their outstanding performance in events such as the Khelo India Games, National Championships, and through open and transparent selection trials organized by the relevant National Sports Federations and the School Games Federation of India. Further, Under the component “Khelo India Centres & Sports Academies” of Khelo India Scheme, the identified talents are given the option to join the accredited Khelo India Academies and are also provided coaching, equipment, medical care, and a monthly out of pocket Allowance (OPA) to ensure their training, competition participation, and overall development.
