(a) to (e): Provision of CCTV Cameras in passenger coaches is an ongoing process. Accordingly, CCTVs cameras in coaches are being fitted in phased manner. So far, around 10,245 coaches have been provided with CCTV camera including Amrit Bharat, Vande Bharat, Tejas and Humsafar rakes.
