ADOPTION OF GREEN STEEL MANUFACTURING

(a) whether it is a fact that there is a need to review the National Steel Policy (NSP) in the wake of some advanced economies imposing carbon tariff on steel imports and the growing need to decarbonize the sector;

(b) whether Government is readying a package to incentivise the adoption of green steel manufacturing in the country; and

(c) if so, the details thereof, and details of the timeframe for its implementation?

(a)to(c): Government has taken various measures in the wake of emerging challenges including decarbonisation and some advanced economies imposing carbon tariff on steel imports. After deliberation with stakeholders, Government has formulated and issued a roadmap and action plan to incentivise the adoption of green steel manufacturing in the country and green transition of steel sector with a view to achieving the net zero carbon emission by 2070.
