PM MITRA PARK SCHEME

2238. SMT. GEETA ALIAS CHANDRAPRABHA:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) the objective of the PM Mitra Park scheme launched by Government;
- (b) the total number of locations that have been selected in the country till date under this scheme;
- (c) the total number of selected locations where PM Mitra Parks have been established;
- (d) whether any location in Uttar Pradesh has been selected under the said scheme; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (e): With a view to attract investment, boost employment generation and position itself strongly in the global market, the Government has approved setting up of 7 PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites with world class infrastructure including plug and play facility with an outlay of Rs. 4,445 cr for a period of seven years upto 2027-28. 18 proposals from 13 States were received under the Scheme. Under PM MITRA Scheme, a total of 7 parks are being established viz. Tamil Nadu (Virudhnagar), Telangana (Warangal), Gujarat (Navsari), Karnataka (Kalaburagi), Madhya Pradesh (Dhar), Maharashtra (Amravati) and one in Uttar Pradesh (Lucknow).
