MSP FOR MILK

223 Dr. M. THAMBIDURAI:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has considered introducing a Minimum Support Price (MSP) for the milk in the country; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and steps taken by Government, if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (SHRI RAJIV RANJAN SINGH ALIAS LALAN SINGH)

(a) & (b) The Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying (DAHD), Government of India does not regulate the procurement and sale prices of milk in the country. Prices are decided by the cooperative and private dairies based on their cost of production and market forces. Milk pricing being free from Government control, this department does not have any proposal to fix Minimum Support Price (MSP) for milk in the country.
