**AIRPORTS IN THE COUNTRY FUNCTIONING UNDER PPP
MODEL**

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of airports in the country functioning on the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model, State-wise and year-wise details;**
- (b) the criteria for selecting private partners under the PPP model;**
- (c) the list of new PPP airports going to be made operational shortly; and**
- (d) whether Government is considering any application from the State of Kerala for establishing new airport under the PPP model?**

ANSWER

(a): Presently, 14 airports in the country are operated by private operators under Public Private Partnership (PPP), details of which are attached at Annexure.

(b): So far, Airports Authority of India (AAI) has leased out eight airports namely, Delhi, Mumbai, Ahmedabad, Jaipur, Lucknow, Guwahati, Thiruvananthapuram and Mangaluru for Operations, Management and Development under Public Private Partnership (PPP). The criteria for selection of Private Partners for Delhi and Mumbai airports was Revenue share whereas the selection criteria for six airports viz. Lucknow, Ahmedabad, Mangaluru Jaipur, Guwahati and Thiruvananthapuram was Per Passenger Fee (PPF) payable to AAI.

(c):

Gol has accorded 'In-Principle" approval for setting up of 21 Greenfield Airports across the country out of which 12 Greenfield airports have been operationalised.

Out of the remaining 9 airports, development of 3 airports namely, Noida (Jewar), Navi Mumbai, and Bhogapuram have been undertaken by respective State Governments under PPP mode.

(d): The Government of India has granted 'Site Clearance' to the Kerala State Industrial Development Corporation (KSIDC) for the establishment of an International Greenfield Airport at Kottayam (Sabarimala) in April, 2023. Implementation of the airport development project at Kottayam, including mode of implementation is the responsibility of State Government/KSIDC.
