### **DIGITIZATION OF PDS**

# 2430 SHRI S. KALYANASUNDARAM: SHRI M. MOHAMED ABDULLA:

Will the Minister of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the progress made in the digitization of the Public Distribution System (PDS) and the steps taken to remove fake ration cards from the system;
- (b) the measures being adopted to ensure that only eligible beneficiaries are included in welfare schemes like PMGKAY and NFSA; and
- (c) the impact of Aadhaar-based authentication, eKYC verification and e-PoS devices in reducing leakages and ensuring transparency in the PDS?

#### ANSWER

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRIMATI NIMUBEN JAYANTIBHAI BAMBHANIYA)

(a): As part of the technology driven Public Distribution System (PDS) reforms, ration cards/beneficiaries database have been completely digitized (100%) in all States/UTs. Further, due to the digitization of ration cards data in all States/UTs, continuous de-duplication of digital data, permanent migration, deaths, identification of ineligible ration cards, etc. the States/UTs have been able to remove ineligible ration cards from the system.

- (b): As per the Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) Control Order 2015, the review of ration cards/beneficiaries list, identification of bogus/ineligible/ duplicate ration cards and inclusion of genuine eligible beneficiaries/households is the responsibility of concerned State/UT Government. In this regard, States/UTs have been advised to undertake proper verification (including field verification) of each identified case to ensure that ration cards of genuine beneficiaries are not deleted. Further, States/UTs continuously issue new ration cards to the genuinely eligible households/beneficiaries in place of cancelled ration cards under ceiling limit of the National Food Security Act (NFSA), to achieve the rightful targeting of subsidised foodgrains.
- (c): Under PDS reforms, 99.8% ration cards are seeded with Aadhaar number at national level and almost all FPSs have been automated by installation of e-PoS devices for the distribution of food-grains in a transparent manner (electronically) through biometric /Aadhaar authentication of PMGKAY beneficiaries. Appox. 98% distribution is done through Aadhaar authentication to curb the leakages and ensuring the transparency in PDS System.

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
