SETTING UP OF NURSING INSTITUTIONS IN HIMACHAL PRADESH

- (a) whether the Central Government has approved the setting up of new nursing institutions in Himachal Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the districts where these institutes would be set up; and
- (c) the provision of the percentage of grants provided by the Central Government for the said nursing institutions?

(a) to (c) Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for “Augmenting Nursing Education - Establishment of new College of Nursing (CoN) in co-location with Medical College” 03 nursing colleges have been approved in the districts of Chamba, Hamirpur and Nahan (Sirmour) in Himachal Pradesh. The fund sharing between Centre and State for the establishment of above three nursing colleges is in the ratio of 90:10 as per the provisions of the scheme for North Eastern/ Special Category states.
