**FACULTY AND STAFF VACANCIES ACROSS AIIMS INSTITUTIONS**

**2505. SHRI MALLIKARJUN KHARGE:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the current number of sanctioned and vacant faculty positions across all AIIMS institutions in the country, institution-wise;
- (b) the total number of non-faculty staff vacancies across these institutions, including nursing and technical staff, for the last three years, category-wise and year-wise;
- (c) the steps being taken to address faculty and staff shortages along with timelines for filling these positions; and
- (d) the measures being implemented to ensure uninterrupted healthcare services?

(a) to (d): The details of Faculty and Non-Faculty posts (including Nursing and Technical staff) in various All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), are placed at Annexure.

Creation of posts and recruitment is a continuous process. In order to expeditiously fill vacant positions in various AIIMS, Centralized Nursing Officer Recruitment Common Eligibility Test (NORCET) and Common Recruitment Examination (CRE) for the Non-faculty posts is conducted by AIIMS Delhi.

In order to provide healthcare services OPD/IPD services are made functional in 19 AIIMS including AIIMS Delhi.
