**FOUR AND SIX LANE NATIONAL HIGHWAYS IN RAJASTHAN**

253. SHRI MADAN RATHORE:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of four lane and six lane national highways that are operational in the border area of Rajasthan;
- (b) the present lane size of highways from Jaipur to Kishangarh and Kishangarh to Pindwara;
- (c) in view of the increasing traffic, whether there is any proposal to upgrade the Jaipur to Kishangarh highway to eight lane and the Kishangarh to Pindwara highway to six lane; and
- (d) if so, by when and if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

(a) A four lane highway connecting Bikaner- Phalodi section from Km. 4+200 to Km. 55+250 of NH-11 is operational in the border area of Rajasthan.

(b) The details of lane status of Jaipur to Kishangarh and Kishangarh to Pindwara section is as under:

Sl. No.	Name of Highway Section	NH Number	Lane Configuration
1	Jaipur to Kisangarh	NH-48	6 lane
2	Kishangarh-Ajmer--Beawar	NH-48	6 lane
3	Beawar-Pali-Pindwara	NH-25, 162 & 62	4 lane

(c) and (d) The DPR for 8 laning of Jaipur to Kishangarh section is awarded and capacity augmentation of this section will be taken up based on the outcome of DPR, availability of funds and inter-se priority of the work. At present there is no proposal for capacity Augmentation of Beawar - Pindwara section.
