UTILISATION OF LIGHTHOUSES AS TOURIST DESTINATIONS

2550. DR. ASHOK KUMAR MITTAL:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government plans to utilise lighthouses as tourist destinations;

(b) if so, the details thereof including the number of lighthouses identified for this purpose and their locations including those in PPP mode;(c)

the steps taken/proposed to be taken by Government to develop the necessaryinfrastru cture and facilities at these lighthouses for tourism;

(d) whether Government has any plan to involve private sector participation in the development and management of lighthouse tourism; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) and (b) Yes. A total of 75 lighthouses have been identified for tourism purposes in 10 States/Union Territories ((list enclosed as Annexure-I). Lighthouse at Mahabalipuramin Tamil Nadu is under development in Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode for tourism purposes.

(c) Infrastructure facilities like museum, amphi-theatre, open air theatre, cafeteria, children play area, gazebo, landscaping and lifts have been developed for tourism purpose in selected lighthouses.

(d) and (e) At presenttourism at Mahabalipuramlighthouse in Tamil Nadu is under development in PPP mode.
