DEVELOPMENT OF JETTY FOR CRUISE IN KARNATAKA

2554. SHRI NARAYANASA K. BHANDAGE:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has any proposal to develop a jetty for cruise route in Krishna river from Almatti of Vijayapur District to Herkal in Bagalkote District in Karnataka;
- (b) if so, the current situation of the proposal; and
- (c) if not, whether the Ministry would take initiative to develop a jetty for such cruise route in Krishna river from Almatti to Herkal?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways under Sagarmala Scheme has undertaken the project of Government of Karnataka for Development of waterways from Almatti to Bagalkot in Karnataka (Ghataprabha River – NW – 41) at an estimated cost of Rs. 12.20 Crores. The project includes Fairway Development, Terminal Development and Berthing Facility. Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction for partial funding was conveyed to Government of Karnataka on 14.3.2022. Further, due to no physical progress under the project for more than one year, the project was categorised under ‘Deemed Deferred Category’ as per Sagarmala Funding Guidelines.
