Will the Minister of PANCHAYATI RAJ be pleased to state:

- (a) the measures taken to ensure effective implementation of the Audit Online application under e-Panchayat Mission Mode Project; and
- (b) the current status on the number of audit plans created and audit reports generated through the Audit Online application?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR PANCHAYATI RAJ

(PROF. S.P. SINGH BAGHEL)

- (a) The Audit Online application was launched by the Ministry of Panchayati Raj on 15th April 2020 to facilitate online auditing of Panchayat accounts & further strengthen the financial management and transparency in the Panchayats.

As outlined in the Operational guidelines for the implementation of the 15th Finance Commission recommendations on Rural Local Bodies (RLBs) grants during the period 2021-22 to 2025-26; one of the mandatory conditions for eligibility of grants is that States must ensure the auditing of RLBs accounts. For the financial years 2021-22 & 2022-23, 25% of RLBs were required to have their accounts audited & from the financial year 2023-24 onwards, 100% of RLBs must be audited.

Regular reviews are conducted with the states to track and evaluate the progress of AuditOnline implementation, ensuring compliance. The 15th Finance Commission grants are being released only to those Rural Local Bodies (RLBs) who have fulfilled the audit conditions

- (b) For the release of finance Commission grants for the financial year 2024-25, Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) are required to have audited accounts for FY2022-23. As on date, the number of audit reports generated for the audit period 2022-23 is **2,52,400**. The State-wise information is placed at Annexure.
