**ROJGAR MELA BY NSDC**

2670. SHRI SANDEEP KUMAR PATHAK:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Rozgar melas organised by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) in the last three years, the number of offer letters provided after each mela, the number of jobs actually taken up by youth after each mela & jobs retained for more than six months by those who accepted the job offer and joined, State-wise/UT-wise and year-wise details thereof; and

(b) the total amount spent on each such Rozgar Mela in the last three years and the financial contribution of the Central Government in each such mela, State/UT-wise and year-wise details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) and (b) The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), Sector Skill Councils, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs) and training providers, organizes Rozgar Mela (Kaushal Mahotsavs) across the country, to facilitate suitable job opportunities to the unemployed youth in private sector. Rozgar Mela is an event where skilled candidates and employers are brought to a common platform to ensure best recruitment/selection choices for an employer and appropriate job opportunities for a skilled candidate.

In last three financial years, NSDC under the aegis of MSDE has organized 8 Rozgar Melas (Kaushal Mahotsavs). In those Rozgar Melas, 1.54 lakh candidates have registered and around 11 thousand candidates have been shortlisted. NSDC does not monitor the candidates who got job opportunity through Rozgar Melas. Rozgar Mela-wise details including amount spent is given below:
