Increase in forest cover

2758. SHRI GOLLA BABURAO:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of forest cover in the country as on date, State-wise;
- (b) the details of increase/decrease in forest cover during the last three years;
- (c) the details of afforestation programmes being run by Government to increase forest cover in the country; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI KIRTI VARDHAN SINGH)

- (a) Forest Survey of India (FSI), Dehradun, an organization under the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, carries out the assessment of forest cover biennially and the findings are published in the India State of Forest Report (ISFR). As per the ISFR 2021, the total forest cover of the country is 7,13,789 square kilometer which is 21.71% of the geographical area of the country. The State/ Union Territory wise details of forest cover in the country are given in **Annexure.**
- (b) As per ISFR 2021 assessment the forest cover has increased by 5,516 square kilometer at national level as compared to the assessment in ISFR 2017.
- (c) &(d) To increase the forest and tree cover, the Central Government provides financial support to the States and Union Territories under various schemes and programmes such as National Mission for a Green India (GIM), Development of Wildlife Habitats, Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA), Nagar Van Yojana, Mangrove Initiative for Shoreline Habitats & Tangible Incomes (MISHTI), etc.
