Human-animal conflicts in Kerala

2762. SHRI HARIS BEERAN:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has allocated any fund to the State of Kerala for fencing the wildl ife sanctuaries and protected forests in the State in order to check the increasing human-animal conflicts in State, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of number human animal conflict occurred since last five years in Kerala;
- (c) whether Government has evolved any plan to address the man-animal conflict in Kerala, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the total causalities during man-animal conflicts during the last five years in India specially in Kerala?

ANSWER

- (a) The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change provides financial assistance to the States/Union Territories including Kerala, for protection of wildlife and its habitat. The Centrally Sponsored Schemesnamely the 'Development of Wildlife Habitats' and 'Project Tiger and Elephant'aims at holistic habitat management including mitigate human animal conflicts. The scheme provides funding for various interventions including animal proof fencing, anti-depredation squads, rapid response teams, ex-gratia relief, technology based animal tracking etc.Details of financial assistance provided to States/Union Territories under the Scheme during the last three years and current year are at Annexure-1 and Annexure-II respectively.
- (b), (c) and The Ministry coordinates with State and Union Territory Governments for assessing information relating to human-wildlife conflict situations leading to human causalities due to conflicts involving wild animals like tigers and elephants. The Ministry through wide ranging technical consultations has brought out species specific guidelines for dealing with human-wildlife conflicts due to Elephant, Gaur, Leopard, Snake, Crocodile, Rhesus Macaque, Wild Pig, Bear, Blue Bull and Blackbuck.

Ministry has also issued holistic advisories and guidelines to the States and Union Territory Governments to deal with human–wildlife conflict situations dated 6.2.2021 and 3.6.2022. The guidelines provide for constitution of State Level Co-ordination Committees. The mandate of these committees include monitoring the human wildlife conflict cases and their geographical spread, and provide guidance

to different departments for actions to be taken to minimise and prevent human wildlife conflict in those areas.

The Ministry has enhanced the amount of ex-gratia relief in case of death or permanent incapacitation due to wild animal attacks during December 2023. At present, the amount of ex-gratia relief payable under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes – 'Development of Wildlife Habitats' and 'Project Tiger and Elephant' is as follows:
