- (a) Whether the National Career Service (NCS) portal is integrated with Government's e-Shram portal for unorganized workers and whether unorganized workers find jobs through the NCS portal;**
- (b) Whether all States have career service digital portals and whether they have been integrated with the NCS portal; and**
- (c) the timeline for integrating all State portals with the NCS portal?**

(a) to (c) The Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India, is running the National Career Service (NCS) Portal which is a one-stop solution for providing career related services including jobs from private and government sectors, information on online & offline job fairs, job search & matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses, skill/training programmes etc. through a digital platform [www.ncs.gov.in].

National Career Service (NCS) portal has been integrated with e-Shram portal and operationalized. The e-Shram registrants can avail all services available on the portal including job search.

The NCS portal has been integrated with 23 States/UTs portals, whereas 7 States/UTs are directly using NCS portal for jobseeker registration.
