**(a) to (d) The Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India, is running the National Career Service (NCS) Portal which is a one-stop solution for providing career related services including jobs from private and government sectors, information on online & offline job fairs, job search & matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses, skill/training programmes etc. through a digital platform [[www.ncs.gov.in](http://www.ncs.gov.in)].**

**The total number of vacancies mobilised through the National Career Service (NCS) portal since its inception, gender-wise, State-wise and sector-wise are given in Annexure-I, Annexure-II and Annexure-III respectively.**

**The module for the international jobs on NCS portal which was launched in April 2022, facilitates Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) registered Recruiting Agents to post international job opportunities on NCS portal. As on 15th November, 2024, the Recruiting Agents have posted 17,169 international vacancies on NCS portal.**
