2799. DR. K. LAXMAN :

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is planning to launch a single window to provide job seekers the facility of job search and skilling services, if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) by when a single window portal for job seekers will be launched;**
- (c) whether National Career Service (NCS) portal utilizes advanced technologies such as Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Meta Data to effectively match job demand with supply;**
- (d) the number of resumes of individual job seekers available on the NCS portal; and**
- (e) whether the system can predict the current and future skilling needs of the youth based on analytics of the resumes?**

(a) to (e) The Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India, is running the National Career Service (NCS) Portal since 2015 which is a one-stop solution for providing career related services including jobs from private and government sectors, information on online & offline job fairs, job search & matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses, skill/training programmes etc. through a digital platform [www.ncs.gov.in]. The NCS portal has been integrated with 23 States/UTs portals, whereas 7 States/UTs are directly using NCS portal for jobseeker registration.

As on 15th November 2024, more than 3.53 crore vacancies have been posted and more than 36.23 lakh employers have registered on NCS Portal. The information submitted including resume by jobseekers is available on the portal for job matching.

Improvements in the portal is a continuous and dynamic process. Changes are planned as per the need of the hour using latest available technologies as and when required.
