PRADHAN MANTRI KAUSHAL VIKAS YOJNA IN ODISHA

280. SMT. MAMATA MOHANTA:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) gender-wise beneficiaries of the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna (PMKVY) in Odisha, the details thereof;
- (b) the number of individuals who have been trained in the Special Project component of PMKVY from Odisha, details thereof year-wise and skills in which they were trained in;
- (c) details of individuals, district-wise, for last three years; and
- (d) the proposed plan to ensure skill development targeted towards graduates through PMKVY 4.0 and details regarding the proposed outlay for the same in Odisha?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)

(a) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing its flagship Scheme Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) since 2015. Under PMKVY, skill training is imparted through Short Term Training (STT) and Re-skilling and Up-skilling through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to youth across the country.

Details of gender-wise beneficiaries of the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna in Odisha is given at *Annexure I*.

(b) Year-wise details of individuals who have been trained in the Special Project component of PMKVY from Odisha and skills in which they were trained is given at *Annexure II*.

(c) District-wise details of individuals for last three years is given at *Annexure III*.

(d) The current version of PMKVY i.e. PMKVY 4.0 aims to provide skilling to 1.5 Crore candidates across the country during the implementation period i.e. FY 2022-23 to FY 2025-26. Under PMKVY 4.0, skill training is provided based on the market demand and open for everyone subject to fulfilling the criteria. To meet the needs of evolving jobs market, new courses are continuously designed and existing courses are also upgraded in consultation with industries, academia and States/UTs and being implemented under the schemes across the country including Odisha. In addition to this, District Skill Development Plans (DSDPs) have been developed by District Skill Committees (DSCs) to assess skill gaps, mapping of industry demand, etc. at district level to ensure alignment of PMKVY courses with local needs. Efforts are regularly made to generate awareness about the schemes through different media platforms with a view to ensure larger coverage of beneficiaries.

The PMKVY 4.0 is a Central Sector Scheme and State-wise outlay has not been set under the Scheme.
