EMPLOYMENT THROUGH EMPLOYMENT EXCHANGES SINCE 2019

2810. SHRI ANIL KUMAR YADAV MANDADI:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of youths that registered for employment in the employment exchanges across the country since 2019, State-wise;
- (b) the details of the employment provided to the youths across the country through employment exchanges during the last five years, State-wise; and
- (c) the details of the employment proposed to be provided to the youths across the country through employment exchanges across the country in coming years, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India, is running the National Career Service (NCS) Portal which is a one-stop solution for providing career related services including jobs from private and government sectors, information on online & offline job fairs, job search & matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses, skill/training programmes etc. through a digital platform [www.ncs.gov.in]. As on 15th November 2024, more than 3.53 crore vacancies have been mobilized on NCS Portal.

One of the objectives of the NCS Scheme is to upgrade the Employment Exchanges to Model Career Centres (MCCs). The Ministry has approved 407 Model Career Centres (MCCs) across the country. These centres connect local youth and other job-seekers with job opportunities through the use of technology as well as career counselling and training. As such these Model Career Centres (MCCs) act as a hub for organising job fairs, mobilising the employers, providing career counselling at local level etc. in collaboration with States and other institutions for the jobseekers and employers through outreach activities.
