VACANCIES IN MINISTRIES AND PSUs

2834. SHRI DEREK O' BRIEN:

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

(a) the number of vacancies in Departments and Ministries of the Union Government in last five years, year-wise and Department-wise;

(b) the number of vacancies in the Union Government for reserved categories like SC, ST and OBC, Department/ Ministry-wise;

(c) the number of vacancies in Government Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) Department/ Ministry-wise; and

(d) the number of vacancies in PSUs for reserved categories like SC, ST and OBC, PSU-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) to (d): Occurrence and filling up of vacant posts, including reserved category vacancies, in various Ministries/Departments and PSUs under the Central Government is a continuous process. The data regarding vacancies is maintained by the respective Ministries/ Departments / PSUs under the Central Government, which have been directed, from time to time, to fill up vacant posts in a time bound manner.

In the matter of appointment by direct recruitment on all India basis by open competition to civil posts and civil services in Ministries / Departments under the Central Government and posts in Central PSUs, reservation is provided to SCs, STs and OBCs @15%, 7.5% and 27% respectively. The persons belonging to EWSs who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs are provided 10% reservation in direct recruitment.
