DEVELOPMENT AND PROPOSALS FOR TOURISM PROJECTS

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of tourism destinations developed in Maharashtra over the last three years, including district-wise specifics from 2019 to the present;
- (b) the major tourism projects proposed in Maharashtra since 2019, including the current status of these projects and details of ongoing work;
- (c) the number of proposals from Maharashtra that are pending with the Central Government along with the reasons for the delay; and
- (d) the steps taken to ensure timely implementation of tourism projects and pending proposals?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): Development and promotion of tourism in the country is primarily undertaken by the concerned State Governments (SGs)/Union Territory Administrations (UTs). The Ministry of Tourism complements the efforts of SGs/UTs by providing financial assistance under its 'Swadesh Darshan (SD)' and 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' by extending financial assistance to the State Governments/UT Administrations. In addition, tourism facilities are also developed by sanctioning projects under its 'Assistance to Central Agencies' scheme by the Ministry of Tourism.

Under the Swadesh Darshan and PRASHAD schemes, the Ministry sanctioned 2 projects and 1 project respectively in the State of Maharashtra, as per the below given details:
