INCREASE IN EXPORTS IN KEY SECTORS

- (a) the export targets for 2029-30 in key sectors such as electronics, textiles and pharmaceuticals; and
- (b) whether the current exports in electronics, textiles and pharmaceuticals sectors are in line with the targets set?

(a) & (b) Although the Government has been working with a USD 1 trillion of merchandise exports by 2030 which includes electronics, textiles and pharmaceuticals, it has to be seen in the context of global geo-political situation, global growth and many other external variables. In the first 8 months of 2024-25 (April-November), India has achieved merchandise exports of US \$ 284.31 billion, which is higher than the export achieved during the corresponding period of last year. The sector-wise export achievement in electronics, textiles and pharmaceuticals sectors during 2024-25 (April-November) are attached at Annexure 1.
