The interns work on policy and implementation issues and contribute in driving digital transformation in the country.

The specific areas under the scheme are chosen every year based on the current priorities and thrust areas of the Ministry. This depends on the strategic priorities of the country in the fields of Electronics and IT including semiconductors, electronics manufacturing, e-governance, cyber laws, emerging technologies and capacity building.
